- 50-52 **Chinese stamps to combat the virus** were published in two designs before their final version was issued, which will not be distributed to foreign subscribers; also some other postmarks etc and stamps from other countries are shown.
- 53-57 **British treaty ports** using Hong Kong stamps and identifying cancels are discussed in this article.
- 57 **Commemorative sheetlet** for Day of the Environment
- 58-61 **Taiwan Numeral Stamps** were used a very short period in 1945 and then overprinted for use under Republic of China rule in Taiwan; article is translated from the English Kiku Shimbun #173 (Dec. 2017); part I in previous issue.
- 62-63 **Railway Mail under the British Expeditionary Force II.** This article deals with the period after the use of the 'BRA railway stamps' until the BRA transferred the railway back to its original owners in September 1902, is translated from Stamps World #76 (1987)
- 64-65 **The very last Emperor** deals with the 12 day restoration period in July 1916, illustrated by two covers showing reversion in postmarks to moon calendar and 'year of the emperor'
- 66 **Customs cancel Lappa** was used in the Chinese Customs office on the islet of Lappa near Macao, but not for postal purposes (as shown by use in 1905)
- 66 **Commemorative cancel from the PRC 1949**
- 67 **Fake News!** Shows three versions of the same postcard showing a British building in Tientsin flying Union Jack, Japanese flag and obscured Japanese flag...
- 67 **Commemorative sheetlets** showing scenes from the book 'Dreams of the Red Chamber'
- 68 **Michel China 2020**, the new catalogue is introduced and discussed
