- 26-30 **Express stamps and express post** traces the history of the express post from its origin in November 1905 to 1934. Both the issued stamps and labels for this service are shown and discussed, as well as the organisation of the service and also some Express covers are shown.
- 30 **Commemorative sheetlets from the PRC** for the China-Eurasia Expo, held yearly in Urumqi, Xinjiang
- 31-34 **Pencil markings from Tientsin** on early 20th century post show the weight in ounces; various covers with these markings are discussed.
- 35-38 **The Taiping Rebellion** was commemorated on 1952 stamps; the article uses Wikipedia to tell the historical background and shows cards issued in 1952 by the Chinese Post alongside the stamps issue.
