- 50-53 **Postcards from China** is the first part of a series on the postcards issued by the Chinese post; this installment deals with the Imperial period.
- 54-55 **China in the years 1916-1928** is a series of articles, of which this is the 2<sup>nd</sup> part, discussing the background to the stamp issues from these years of the ‘warlords period’. It deals with the 1924 set commemorating the new Chinese Constitution as proclaimed by the new president Cao Kun.
- 55 **Commemorative cancel from the PRC** from the year 1958 is shown
- 56-58 The **Tchong-King overprints on Indochina** stamps from 1902 shown in the Yvert&Tellier catalogue and also in the Chan are pure fantasy products without any postal credentials. The Chan shows Fournier fakes of these fantasy stamps(!).

- 58 **Revenue stamp for the quality control of sun helmets** is shown
